Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for another amazing year as your school principal. On behalf of the Belle Creek Charter School staff, I want to extend a warm back to school welcome to new and returning families for the 2019-2020 year. A special welcome goes out to our incoming Kindergarten students who are new to our school and to new staff joining our incredible team. As we start the year, we will continue our work towards ensuring the safety, social wellbeing and engaging curriculum for your child/children.

In order to support a smooth transition from summer, we have provided important information in this letter. Please read it all carefully.

### Registration:

All parents/guardians must attend registration and sign important registration documentation prior to your student starting school. Please make every attempt to attend registration.

Registration days are July 31<sup>st</sup> from 12:00 PM – 6:00 PM and August 1st from 7:30 AM – 4:00 PM.

Belle Creek will also offer electronic payments for registration and other fees assigned to your student. These fees can be paid online through our school web store and can be paid before you come in for registration. *At registration we can only accept cash or check in the exact amount.*

*All past fees must be paid before you will receive your student's schedule/ teacher assignment.* This includes the registration fee of \$20.00 per student and any past due fees that your student may have - missing library books, lost locks, or returned checks/ returned check fees. The registration fee can be waived for free lunch/reduced lunch students with a copy in hand of the letter received from the district.

School supply lists are attached at the end of this letter.

### Uniforms:

Approved uniform shirt vendors will be at registration on all three days as well as on our Back to School night/ Open House August 7th. The vendor list is also available on our website. We will no longer have the uniforms in the office during the school year for parents and students to go through at their convenience. Parents please consider sending a change of clothing with your younger student in his/her backpack.

Last year was a transitional uniform year. For the 2019-2020 school year we will no longer accept the old "Hawk" logo or the green or white shirt tops. Approved uniform shirts, sweatshirts and sweaters must have the Wild Cat logo on the upper left of a solid royal blue, navy blue, grey, maroon or pink shirt. Pants must be a solid khaki (tan), navy blue or black with no cargo pockets.

### Dress Code:

Students are required to conform to the school's dress code. With summer coming to an end and a new school year starting, please remember students, male and female must wear their hair clean, neat, and traditionally styled. No radical hairstyles. Boys may not wear any mohawk haircuts, drawings, designs, letters, lines or numbers shaved in their head, for any reason. Students' hair must be styled traditionally with only natural colors. Students may not have tattoos visible, whether permanent or temporary. Please refer to section 2.5 Dress Code in the Parent/ Student Handbook for additional requirements. Our dress code will be strictly enforced.

### Back to School Night/ Open House:

Our Back to School Night is August 7th from 4:00-6:00 p.m. During your visit you will have opportunity to meet the teacher, drop off all school supplies, find your child's seat and coat hook/locker and become acquainted with your child's new "home away from home".

### Classroom Placement:

When teachers assemble homeroom classes, they try to make them heterogeneous. The major factors are your child's demonstrated achievement; the quality of the student's citizenship; the child's work and study habits; whether he or she may need behavior support; if he or she is a leader or a follower; how a child's personality will fit with the others in the class; and the boy-girl ratio in the class.

We do NOT consider social factors such as the number of friends the child will have in the new class, or what class his or her best friend is in. Children are adaptable and will make friends wherever they are placed. We do know that parents sometimes have preferences for teachers; however, we cannot place children in classes only based on the parents' preferences or the teacher's reputation in the community.

We group children for instructional purposes and placing in class based on any other factor would defeat this purpose. You need to trust the staff to make the best placement possible with all the information at our disposal. We will do the best job of placement we can, because it is important to us that every child has a good chance for success.

### First Day of School:

All students report to school on August 8th.

### School Hours:

Kindergarten & 1st Grade - 8:30 am -3:20 pm 2nd - 3rd Grade - 8:30 am-3:30pm 4th - 8th Grade - 8:25 am – 3:30 pm

For the safety of students, parents are asked not to drop students off at school prior to 8:15 am unless participating in the breakfast program.

**Please note there is no supervision in the morning for your students BEFORE 8:15 a.m. or after school AFTER 3:45 p.m.**

If your student is not in a school sponsored activity before or after these times they are to remain under their parents' supervision while on school grounds.

After 3:45 p.m., the playground does become a neighborhood playground and any concerns that occur during this time will need to be reported to the Commerce City Police Department (303 288-1535).

For your convenience Belle Creek Charter School offers before school care for children who must be dropped off before 8:15 a.m. For information regarding this program contact YMCA at 720-524-2792.

After school programs are for Belle Creek Charter School students in grades K-8 whose parents are unable to pick them up at 3:30 p.m. There are two options to choose from: YMCA at 720-524-2792. Remember that arriving late to school is a disruption to the classes' already in progress and does affect students who arrive to classes on time. It's important to know that your students will be missing valuable learning time in the classrooms when they become habitually tardy.

Please also consider that at Belle Creek we put students and their learning first. We are asking our parents and guardians to please remember this before picking up your student early for the sake of convenience. Our students are receiving valuable instruction all day long.

Kindergarten - 4th grades will line up on the playground blacktop according to their homeroom Our 5th and 6th grade will line up by the south side door next to the bike racks. Teachers will be on hand to receive your child. Our 7th and 8th grade will line up by the cafeteria.

Staff will be in the parking lot to direct traffic flow. It is important that you follow the directions of the staff and follow all posted traffic signs. We would like to inform /remind you that there is NO parking in the passenger drop-off zones, the unauthorized locations and in the Staff Parking Lot. Please see the attached pick up and drop off procedures.

#### Cafeteria and Lunchroom:

Belle Creek partners with School District 27-J Nutritional Service Program. The hours for the cafeteria staff are 7:30am - 2:30pm. If you need to reach them during the day you may call the school and we will put you through to X 165. Ms. Jan Banta is our Kitchen Manager. She can be reached at [jbanta@sd27j.net](mailto:jbanta@sd27j.net). You may also pay online for your students' meals at [www.payschoolscentral.com](http://www.payschoolscentral.com). You will need your students ID # which you can get at registration from our office staff.

Our breakfast program begins at 7:45 am and ends at 8:15 am. If your student participates in the breakfast program, they must enter in the door labeled #4 - Cafeteria on the west side of the building and exit those doors to line up with their classes outside after meal. School District 27-J accepts online payments through Pay Schools Central. We also have a link on our website as well.

Free and Reduced lunch forms for the 2019-2020 school year will be available at registration. Please apply for free or reduced lunches via the School District 27-J website, [www.sd27j.org](http://www.sd27j.org) Nutrition Services Department, <https://www.sd27j.org/Page/294>. This is the quickest way to apply and receive your letter from the district.

### Visitors/Volunteers:

All parents, guardians, visitors and guests entering Belle Creek during the school day must do so through the main entrance only labeled #1, ring the bell, and wait to be identified. A video camera located in the monitoring device transmits a picture of the visitor to the office. Please look at the black box so we can identify you. Once identified, the door will open. All visitors must report to the office and be prepared to provide a driver's license or ID to enter the building and to sign in and receive a visitor's identification badge. The safety of our children is our number one priority. If you are interested in volunteering in our classrooms or at our school, please contact the front office for a volunteer application packet.

### PTO:

Our Parent Teacher Organization is an important member of our school community. The PTO is a volunteer-based organization that spends countless hours to support Belle Creek. Each year our PTO put together fundraisers, and fun events for our school and community.

### Communication:


We encourage communication between parents and teachers. However, because of their teaching responsibilities, teachers will not be called to the phone during instructional hours (8:15 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.). If you would like to talk with a teacher about your child, you may leave a voice mail message, or you may email the teacher and you will receive a call back at the conclusion of their workday. Staff are available to assist students and parents until 4:30 pm each day.

If at any time you have a concern with a teacher or staff regarding your child's education or school procedures, **it's very important that you respectfully communicate with that teacher or staff first prior to administration.** If your concern is not resolved, please call office to speak with an Assistant Principal or myself.

We also encourage you to set up your Infinite Campus account to keep up to date on your student's progress, grades and attendance. Please ask to receive your log in information if you do not already have it, at registration.

You may also receive information on what is happening in the classrooms by using the Teacher's own website, or by school notes that can be found on our website under daily, staff pages. Please note that most, if not all, our communications are sent via email to the parent/guardians and are posted on our website. If you do not have an email on file, please make sure to add one during registration so you can be assured not to miss important communications from our school throughout the year.

Estimados Padres/Tutores,

Gracias por otro año increíble como director de la escuela. En nombre del personal de Belle Creek Charter School, quiero extender una cálida bienvenida a la escuela a las familias nuevas y que regresan para el año 2019-2020. Una bienvenida especial va a nuestros estudiantes entrantes de Kindergarten que son nuevos en nuestra escuela y a nuevo personal que se une a nuestro increíble equipo. Al comenzar el año, continuaremos nuestro trabajo para garantizar la seguridad, el bienestar social y el plan de estudios atractivo para su hijo/niños. Con el fin de apoyar una transición sin problemas desde el verano, hemos proporcionado información importante en esta carta. Por favor, léalo todo detenidamente.

Registro:

Todos los padres/tutores deben asistir a la inscripción y firmar documentación importante de inscripción antes de que su estudiante comience la escuela. Por favor, haga todos los intentos para asistir a la inscripción.

Los días de inscripción son del 31 de julio de 12:00 PM a 6:00 PM y del 1 de agosto de 7:30 AM a 4:00 PM.

Belle Creek también ofrecerá pagos electrónicos para el registro y otras tarifas asignadas a su estudiante. Estas tarifas se pueden pagar en línea a través de nuestra tienda web de la escuela y se pueden pagar antes de que usted venga para el registro. En el registro sólo podemos aceptar efectivo o cheque en la cantidad exacta.

Todas las tarifas anteriores deben ser pagadas antes de que usted reciba el horario de su estudiante / asignación de maestro. Esto incluye la cuota de inscripción de \$20.00 por estudiante y cualquier cargo ventoso que su estudiante pueda tener - libros de biblioteca perdidos, cerraduras perdidas, o cheques devueltos / cargos de cheque sdevuelto. La cuota de inscripción se puede renunciar para el almuerzo gratuito / almuerzo reducido estudiantes con una copia en la mano de la carta recibida del distrito.

Las listas de suministros escolares se adjuntan al final de esta carta.

Uniformes:

Los vendedores de camisas de uniforme aprobados estarán en el registro en los tres días, así como en nuestra noche de regreso a la escuela / Open House 7 de agosto. La lista de proveedores también está disponible en nuestro sitio web. Ya no tendremos los uniformes en la oficina durante el año escolar para que los padres y estudiantes puedan pasar por su conveniencia. Los padres por favor consideren enviar un cambio de ropa con su estudiante más joven en su mochila.

El año pasado fue un año de uniforme de transición. Para el año escolar 2019-2020 no aceptaremos el antiguo logotipo "Hawk" o las camisetas verdes o blancas. Las camisas, sudaderas y suéteres uniformes aprobados deben tener el logotipo de Wild Cat en la parte superior izquierda de una camisa sólida azul real, azul marino, gris, granate o rosa. Los pantalones deben ser un caqui sólido (tan), azul marino o negro sin bolsillos de carga.

Código de vestimenta:

Los estudiantes deben cumplir con el código de vestimenta de la escuela. Con el fin del verano y el comienzo de un nuevo año escolar, recuerde que los estudiantes, hombres y mujeres deben usar su cabello limpio, limpio y tradicionalmente peinado. Sin peinados radicales. Los niños no pueden usar cortes de pelo mohawk, dibujos, diseños, letras, líneas o números afeitados en su cabeza, por cualquier razón. El cabello de los estudiantes debe ser peinado tradicionalmente con sólo colores naturales. Es posible que los estudiantes no tengan tatuajes visibles, ya sean permanentes o temporales. Por favor, referirse a la sección 2.5 Código de Vestimenta en el Manual para Padres/Estudiantes para requisitos adicionales. Nuestro código de vestimenta será estrictamente aplicado.

Regreso a la noche escolar / Casa abierta:

Nuestra noche de regreso a la escuela es el 7 de agosto de 4:00-6:00 p.m. Durante su visita tendrá la oportunidad de conocer al maestro, dejar todos los útiles de la escuela, encontrar el asiento y el abrigo de su hijo y familiarizarse con el nuevo "hogar lejos de casa" de su hijo.

Colocación en el aula:

Cuando los maestros reúnen clases de aula, tratan de hacerlos heterogéneos. Los principales factores son el logro demostrado de su hijo; la calidad de la ciudadanía del estudiante; hábitos de trabajo y estudio del niño; si

él o ella puede necesitar apoyo conductual; si él o ella es un líder o un seguidor; cómo encajará la personalidad de un niño con los demás de la clase; y la relación niño-chica en la clase.

NO consideramos factores sociales como el número de amigos que el niño tendrá en la nueva clase, o en qué clase se encuentra su mejor amigo. Los niños son adaptables y harán amigos dondequiera que se coloquen. Sabemos que los padres a veces tienen preferencias para los maestros; sin embargo, no podemos colocar a los niños en clases sólo en función de las preferencias de los padres o la reputación del maestro en la comunidad. Agrupamos a los niños con fines de instrucción y la colocación en clase basada en cualquier otro factor derrotaría este propósito. Es necesario confiar en el personal para hacer la mejor colocación posible con toda la información a nuestra disposición. Haremos el mejor trabajo de colocación que podamos, porque es importante para nosotros que cada niño tenga una buena oportunidad de éxito.

Primer día de clases:

Todos los estudiantes se reportan a la escuela el 8 de agosto.

Horario Escolar:

Kindergarten & 1st Grado - 8:30 am -3:20 pm 2nd - 3rd Grado - 8:30 am-3:30pm 4th - 8th Grade - 8:25 am - 3:30 pm

Para la seguridad de los estudiantes, se les pide a los padres que no den a los estudiantes en la escuela antes de las 8:15 am a menos que participen en el programa de desayuno.

Tenga en cuenta que no hay supervisión por la mañana para sus estudiantes ANTES de las 8:15 a.m. o después de la escuela DESPUES de las 3:45 p.m.

Si su estudiante no está en una actividad patrocinada por la escuela antes o después de estas horas deben permanecer bajo la supervisión de sus padres mientras están en la escuela  
Motivos.

Después de las 3:45 p.m., el área de juegos infantiles se convierte en un área de juegos para niños del vecindario y cualquier inquietud que ocurra durante este tiempo tendrá que ser reportada al Departamento de Policía de Commerce City (303 288-1535).

Para su comodidad Belle Creek Charter School ofrece antes de la escuela de cuidado para los niños que deben ser dejados antes de las 8:15 a.m. Para obtener información sobre este programa, comuníquese con YMCA al 720-524-2792.

Recuerde que llegar tarde a la escuela es una interrupción de las clases ya en curso y afecta a los estudiantes que llegan a las clases a tiempo. Es importante saber que a sus estudiantes les faltará un valioso tiempo de aprendizaje en las aulas cuando se vuelvan habitualmente tardíos.

Visitantes/Voluntarios:

Una cámara de video ubicada en el dispositivo de monitoreo transmite una imagen del visitante a la oficina. Por favor, mire la caja negra para que podamos identificarlo. Una vez identificada, la puerta se abrirá. Todos los visitantes deben presentarse a la oficina y estar preparados para proporcionar una licencia de conducir o identificación para entrar en el edificio y para iniciar sesión y recibir una insignia de identificación del visitante. La seguridad de nuestros hijos es nuestra prioridad número uno. Comunicación:

También le recomendamos que configure su cuenta de Infinite Campus para mantenerse al día sobre el progreso, las calificaciones y la asistencia de su estudiante. Por favor, solicite recibir su información de inicio de sesión si aún no la tiene, en el momento del registro.

También puede recibir información sobre lo que está sucediendo en las aulas utilizando el sitio web del Maestro, o mediante notas de la escuela que se pueden encontrar en nuestro sitio web en páginas diarias del personal.

Tenga en cuenta que la mayoría, si no todas, nuestras comunicaciones se envían por correo electrónico a los padres/tutores y se publican en nuestro sitio web. ## Belle Creek Charter School Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedure

**MORNING DROP-OFF:** BCCS has received permission from the Fire Marshal to use the gated fire lane that encircles the school building as a parent drop-off & pick-up zone. This use requires parents to always stay in their vehicle and use a one-way circulation pattern so that students (un)load on the curb side of the vehicle. The right lane is designated as a "Hug and Drop" lane, which means you must drop your child & immediately pull out; no parking or extended waiting, please! The left lane is a moving lane only. At other times of the day this area is closed to motor vehicle traffic. There is a **ONE WAY** loop for drop-off & pick-up. Parents should **not** exit their vehicles in the loading lanes. If your child has been released & you need to help them load & need longer than (1) one minute or if you need to meet with your teacher, please use the parking lot. Please enter from Belle Creek Blvd. at the East Entrance and proceed either to the smaller east building entrance circle or the larger west playground circle. If for any reason, you need to leave your vehicle, please park in the southeast lot. **Do not leave your vehicle unattended** in the loading zone. (*Teachers are on duty beginning at 8:15 AM & will be wearing an orange vest.*)

**AM Bell Rings @ 8:20 AM**

**4 - 8<sup>th</sup> begins 8:25 AM**

**K - 3<sup>rd</sup> begins 8:30 AM**

**PARALLEL PARK:** The inside lane is designed as a *stopping lane* only. Cars should **not** move except to pull in or out of their parallel open space. If all inner lane spaces are occupied, then circle around the outer lane. Pull into the inner lane when space becomes available. You do not have to wait in line; if you see an opening, you may pull up to fill that spot. The outside lane is a *moving lane* only; students should **not** be picked-up or dropped-off from this lane. Students must wait until the parent has found a spot, before attempting to get into their car. **All** students should enter / exit their vehicles from the curb side only!

**AFTERNOON PICK-UP:** Please enter the East Drive & **signal** to enter the *loading lane* and pick-up your children, then **signal** & proceed on to the *through lane* to exit the campus. Please drop-off and pick-up students as quickly as possible so that others can get into the parking lot. Pick-Up times are as follows:

**PM Bell Rings @ 3:20 PM: K - 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Classes**

**2<sup>nd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Grades: 3:30 PM**

**PLEASE REMEMBER** that when you are parking at *any* school event we need to be good neighbors. Please be sure to follow street parking signage & not to park in front of *fire hydrants* or the resident *mailbox area*. No U-turns near or around the school, including in the adjacent neighborhood. Be sure that you do not park in private driveways & remember that residents *only* may park in front of their houses. If neighborhood residents would walk to & from school activities that will save parking & congestion.

**CROSSING GUARDS:** You will notice that we have several friendly traffic directors (orange vests) to help with traffic flow and help students cross the street. If you need assistance, please do not hesitate to ask them for help. No jaywalking. All students should use appropriate crosswalks at drives or streets. A crossing guard will be at Boston and 107th Ave. from 8:15 - 8:30 AM and 3:20 - 3:45 PM.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER:** If it is raining / snowing or the temperature is extremely cold, we will have an **INSIDE DAY**. Signs will be posted for your convenience. Students will be dropped off / picked up directly from the school lobby.

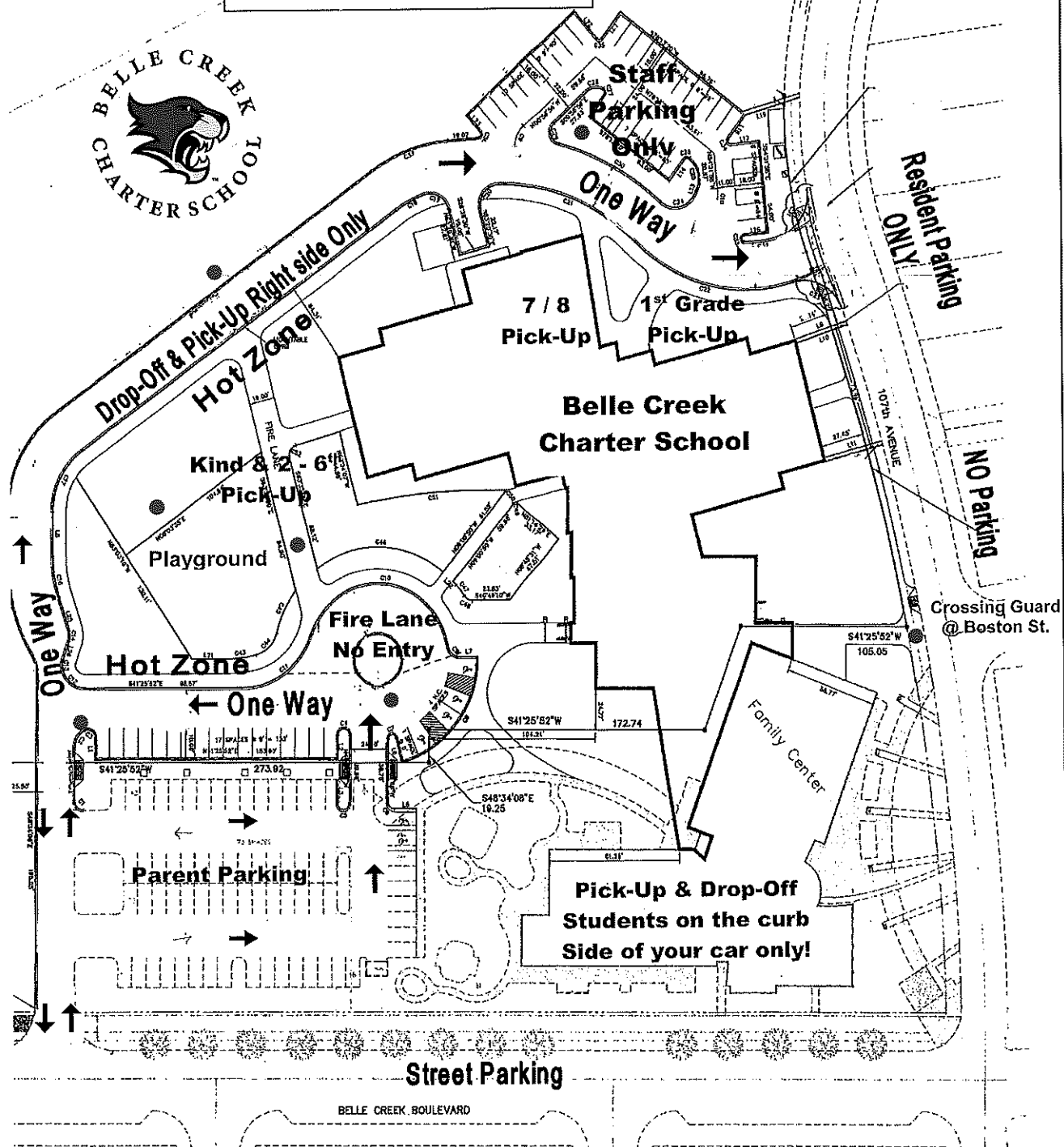
**DRIVE SLOWLY:** The speed limit for all vehicles driving on campus is (5) five miles per hour. Be especially cautious when driving near loading children. Students should not have to watch for speeding cars or have to cross a driveway in order to get to their vehicle. Driving through our campus is a "***NO Cell Phone Zone***". Please refrain from using your cell phone while picking up your child. The northwest parking lot is designated for Staff Only.

**BE SAFE:** If you park in the parking lot, students may not cross the drive unless they are personally escorted by a parent to their car. When driving in a *school zone* slow down and be vigilant in watching for students. Always come to a complete stop at stop signs and give pedestrians the right-of-way. **No** skateboards or scooters may be used & bikes should be *walked on* & off campus. **No oversized** or vehicles carrying *trailers* can proceed through the drop-off / pick-up lanes. Please park on the street. We thank you in advance for your cooperation in implementing these safety procedures to protect all of our children.

**HOT ZONE:** After-School Cars should **not** remain in the *Hot Zone* Pick-Up Area (*Fire Lanes*) more than (5) five minutes. If you need longer to wait for your child, please exit the *Hot Zone* area & use the parking lot or park on the street.

**Belle Creek Charter School Drop-Off / Pick-Up Map**

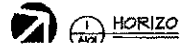
Red Dot indicates Safety Patrol & Traffic Directors
